Most significant accomplishments/activities this month

- ITS Facet Meeting Held monthly meeting on Tuesday, December 8, 2020. Agenda included updates from 4 subcommittees: Umbrella/STEAM PLUS, Mission of Grace, Danglers/Fund Raising and International Day Observances. Agenda also included a debrief and celebration of the successful ITS STEAM PLUS Webinar and preparation for Holiday Party/Danglers Campaign appeal. (14 of 18 Facet members attended the meeting)
- Umbrella/STEAM PLUS Conducted ITS STEAM PLUS webinar on December 7th focused on cultural
 adaptability which is one of 13 dimensions required for Foreign Service Officers. Participants heard from three
 current diplomats serving as foreign service officers and discussed potential issues associated with living
 abroad and working with other cultures.
- 3. 2020 Danglers Campaign At the Holiday Party on December 12th, chapter members and guests were given the opportunity to give using the new Text to Give platform. Donations will also be accepted electronically using Eventbrite and via mail through January 31, 2021. To date, \$7,200 of the \$7,500 goal has been pledged. Actual payments received against pledges total approximately \$7,000. Funds raised will support the school meals program for 350 children and the construction of the initial cable to provide internet to the school.at the Mission of Grace in Haiti.
- 4. **International Observances** Published article and developed content for social media post to observe the United Nations International Day for Elimination of Violence Against Women on November 25, 2020.
